Managing Compact Cases

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- Common Practices
 - Create and use a consistent format for recording information
 - MIC3 will make the format created by Deanna McLaughlin, TN, on the website.
 - Gather essential information
 - Name
 - Contact information
 - District(s) involved
 - Identify which component of the Compact is violated
- Timeline
 - Documenting the case timeline
 - Date/time you were contacted
 - Dates you followed up with the various individuals
 - Dates you contacted Commissioners from other involved states
 - Dates you contacted the concerned individual
- Who Contacts Commissioners?
 - Parents/guardians
 - School district personnel
 - School liaison officers (SLO)
 - Commissioners from other states
 - Others
- Who Do Commissioners Contact?
 - Members of your state council who may be helpful (e.g., educators, military members)
 - Commissioners from other states
 - May be individuals who have a similar sized state
 - May be the Commissioner from the other state involved
 - The National MIC3 office staff

- More on Who to Contact
 - If you are not an educator and need education related information
 - Educational representatives on your council
 - Your state department of education or public instruction
 - The division of pupil services, student services, or legal counsel may be a good starting point
 - If you are not in the military and need military related information
 - Military representative on your council
 - State school liaison officer (SLO)
 - State Department of Military Affairs
 - Commanders of local National Guard or Active Duty military bases
 - State Family Program Manager
 - State Youth and Children Program Coordinator
- Best Resources
 - Compact language
 - State legislation
 - State council members with different areas of experience and expertise
 - National MIC3 office staff
 - State department of education or public instruction
 - State department of military affairs
 - Local National Guard or Active Duty military base personnel
 - Other Commissioners
