 - Representative from a Military installation (Open)
 - o Representative from the Executive Branch (Lachelle and Erica)
 - o Representative from the Legislative Branch (Senator Hutchings)
 - We can include any other office or stakeholder groups as we deem appropriate
 - Nancy suggested recruiting a representative from the National Guard
 - Erica will check on a potential person for this
 - Erica will check to see who handles the appointments through the Governor's office (Gabi Farmer)
