ITEM 1 – Call to Order

1. District of Columbia (DC) Compact Commissioner-Designee Joseph Hood called the meeting to order at 11:02 AM ET. Roll call was conducted, and a quorum was established. Ms. Aliyah McNeely, Legislative Policy Advisor, Council of the District of Columbia was not present.

ITEM 2 – Welcome and Introductions

2. Commissioner-Designee Hood welcomed Nedra Barnes-Larrieux, Tashina Andrus, and Alonso Hay as meeting guests, allowing them to introduce themselves.

ITEM 3 – MIC3 Business

3. **Update on DC’s Citation Correction** – Commissioner-Designee Hood reported that a correction to DC’s Compact citation was submitted to the Council of the District of Columbia. A copy of the correction was forwarded to Ms. Aliyah McNeely for her review.

4. **Proposed MIC3 Dues Increase** – Commissioner-Designee Hood provided an overview of a proposed dues increase that would be voted on at the 2025 Annual Business Meeting (ABM). The increase would raise the current dues formula of \$1.15 per military dependent to \$1.78 in fiscal year (FY) 2027, with a minimum threshold of \$4,000. Hood also explained how the dues were used to fund the Commission’s programs and services. This was a recap of the proposed increase from the June 30, 2025 meeting, and no Council members had questions concerning the proposal. The Council then moved to a formal vote, with Hood entertaining motions to move the previous question. Superintendent Mitchell moved the previous question, which was then seconded by Colonel Nelson. The vote to move the previous question was unanimous. Then members vote on the motion at hand, which was “to direct the DC MIC3 Commissioner Designee, Joseph Hood, to represent the District of Columbia in the 2025 MIC3 Annual Business Meeting by voting to approve the proposed dues increase.” Superintendent Mitchell moved that the motion be approved, and Colonel Nelson seconded the motion. The

motion was approved unanimously.

ITEM 4 – Adjournment

5. Commissioner Hood reminded members that the next purple star schools working group would be on October 3, 2025 at 3PM ET. Dr. Mitchell made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Colonel Nelson. The vote to adjourn was unanimous. Commissioner-Designee Hood adjourned the meeting at 11:15 AM ET.
