Old Business:

3:39 – Review Meeting minutes from June 2021

- Erica Legerski Spoke to General Porter and noted that Steve has retired and will not be at the Guard anymore. He is still with State Gov but not with the guard. Erica also Spoke with Chris Smith at the Guard (Legal council). He reviewed the Powerpoint. They are really learning towards option #5.
- Lachelle provided data that the Guard shared with Chad.
- Chad asked for motion to approve minutes from June 21

3:41 -New Business:

- Chad – The task of this meeting is to decide what Wyoming’s State Council recommendation is about adding National Guard and Reserve to the compact.
  - Sticking points for Chad is the potential for an increase in dues given the budget challenges Wyoming is starting to face
- Erica had emailed the data to Chad that the council requested.
  - Questions the council wanted answered
    - Currently how many Reserve/Guard service members are residing in Wyoming under Titles 5,10,and 32
      - Air Guard - 742
      - Army Guard - 1309
      - Total - 2051
    - Currently how many Reserve/Guard school aged dependents (ages 5-18)
      - 783
    - Break out between Air Guard and Army Guard
      - Was difficult in defining this break out
    - Final question. How many Reserve/Guard families as well as school aged dependents (ages 5-18) moved under the interstate compact PCS orders
      - Total of 10 PCS moves
      - 7 had children
- Discussion Chad – We know that under Title 10 that reserve and National Guard are covered anyway. Is prudent for us to recommend doing another option other than #5, or maybe even option #4.

- Chad asked for questions or feedback surrounding options #4 or #5.
- Conversation continued around the number of students affected, cost, current supports by districts.
- Nancy asked of the students who PCS'd, were there any issues with those 7 children with transition of school?
- Erica noted that she has not received any phone calls that children are having any problems here in the state.
- Chad asked for consensus of the group and at this time the committed agreed to choose Option #5.
- Thom will work with Chad to select a date for the next meeting and send out an invite when that is completed.
