Daron Korte has been Minnesota's MIC3 commissioner-designee since Minnesota joined the compact in 2014. In his time on the commission, Mr. Korte has served as chair of the Compliance Committee (2018-2021) and is currently Vice Chair of the commission (2023-Present). He is the Assistant Commissioner for the Minnesota Department of Education's Office of Student Support Services, which includes the divisions of Special Education; Nutrition Program Services; and Charter Schools. In these areas, he supervises agency implementation of state and federal legislation, guides the development of policy and budget recommendations, and represents the commissioner with external stakeholders. Mr. Korte serves as a general legal adviser to the agency and commissioner.

Mr. Korte previously served as the department's director of government relations. Prior to his work at the department, he served as committee administrator and counsel for the Minnesota Senate Education Policy and Finance Committee. He has also worked in the school law division of Chicago Public Schools. Mr. Korte has a law degree from DePaul University College of Law, and a Bachelor of Arts in sociology from the University of Minnesota Twin Cities.
