III. New Business

Chancellor Oliva provided general updates and discussed Governor DeSantis' military budget proposal, which is designed to support Florida's National Guard.

Gov. DeSantis want to push forward 100 million dollars to establish the Florida National Guard. This will include volunteers for the National Guard.

- The HB153 bill on interstate compact has been filed. They would like to increase members from 7 to 8.
- HB465- US Armed Forces Revises definitions to include U.S. Space Force
- Rule notice: It is suggested that the draft is shared to board members and stakeholders for feedback before the March meeting.

Commissioner Buehn introduced Mr. Wayne Taylor, who was newly appointed to the council. Also addressed a conversation he had with the Concerned Veterans of America

- Jimmy Smith (Director) Inquiring on the HB153. Interest group is supportive of the bill. Mr. Smith was a former representative.

Cherise, the National Director of the Compact highlighted the implementation and launch of the webinar series from MIC3.

- January a national military survey was sent out to military teens. Researchers will review and share the experiences about the mental health retrospective of what kids are dealing with today.

Felicia shared with the group the date in which Purple Up would be celebrated. It will be April 20, 2022.

Kay McKinley- due to COVID social emotional/resiliency; military facilities has done the minimal to get the best possible care.

Elaine Lajeunesse- Praise report- midyear PTS team created outstanding videos (article 7) highlighting two seniors receive a reciprocal diploma.

Bob-Steve Horton- Data reported and collected by Air force shows districts in a less favorable light. How is the data being collected? Jacob agrees the data collected does not reflect the students. Suggest contacting mental health services within the districts to make sure everyone is on the same page.
