Nick Sojka has served as a board of education attorney since 1993, and since 2018 has served as the Board Attorney for Cumberland County Schools (CCS), the fifth largest district (49,000 students) in North Carolina, and a top 100 district nationwide. Immediately adjacent to Fort Bragg and Pope and Simmons Army Airfields, CCS prides itself on its support for military families and their students.

Mr. Sojka is a native of Durham, North Carolina, and earned his bachelor's degree from the College of William & Mary, and his juris doctor from the University of Virginia. In 2017, he received the Marvin R. Pittman Champions for Education Award presented by the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction. A frequent presenter on education law topics, he has served as a guest lecturer at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, Fayetteville State University, the University of North Carolina at Pembroke, and Methodist University. Mr. Sojka and his wife Lucy have been married for 33 years and have two grown children and one grandchild.

Mr. Sojka was appointed by Governor Roy Cooper as the North Carolina MIC3 Commissioner in May, 2020.
