Deanna M. McLaughlin is a dedicated public servant and advocate for military families, with deep roots in **Clarksville, Tennessee**. In **November 2011**, then-Governor Bill Haslam appointed her as the **Tennessee Commissioner to the Military Interstate Children's Compact Commission (MIC3)**, a position she has held as the state's sole commissioner since its inception. She is also a huge advocate for **Tennessee's Purple Star School Award Program**.

Originally from the Pacific Northwest, McLaughlin moved to Fort Bragg, North Carolina, in 1992 after marrying David P. McLaughlin. Following his reassignment to the 101st Airborne Division, she became a fixture at **Fort Campbell** in October 1993. Her commitment to the military community includes serving five years as a **Family Readiness Group Leader** through two Operation Iraqi Freedom deployments, a **CARE Team Member**, a **Citizens for Fort Campbell Member**, a **Welcome Home Ceremony Organizer**, and a **Ride Captain for the Patriot Guard Riders**.

In **2006**, McLaughlin made history by becoming the **first active-duty military spouse elected to the Clarksville City Council**. She served three consecutive four-year terms, ending in 2018. Following a brief hiatus, she successfully returned to the council in **2022**, winning a vacated seat as a write-in candidate with 66% of the vote.

Current Civic and Committee Involvement

On the City Council, McLaughlin currently chairs the **Finance Committee**, the **Gas & Water Committee**, and the **Restoring Clarksville Initiative Task Force**. Her other council roles include serving on the Designations, Legislative, and Neighborhood and Community Services Committees.

Beyond the council, she serves as a **Customs House Museum Board Member** and a member of the **Daughters of the American Revolution** (Captain William Edmiston Chapter). She is also a **Girl Scout Mentor** and actively organizes community events such as **Patriots Park Flags for the Fallen** and **Wreaths Across America**.

Awards and Recognition

Mrs. McLaughlin's decades of service have earned her numerous accolades, including the **Department of the Army Award for Patriotic Civilian Service** and the **Commander's Award for Civilian Service**. Other honors include the **Alzheimer's Association Champion** award, the **Kentucky Colonel Designation**, and two separate **City of Clarksville Key to the City** honors (2010 and 2018).

Deanna and her husband, **1SG Retired David P. McLaughlin**, reside in Clarksville. They are the proud parents of an adult daughter, Kaitlan, and two Golden Retrievers, Vader and Saber.
