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What We Do

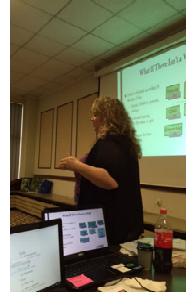
- ❑ STOMP offers virtual workshops across multiple days, two-day in-person workshops and 90 minute-webinars throughout the United States and overseas for military families and military personnel of all branches of service. STOMP workshops and webinars are funded by the Army and Air Force who determine location and topics per installation.
- ❑ Workshops are free and designed to provide information and resources to EFMP military families, individuals with disabilities, to help them access and navigate the educational and medical services.
- ❑ Attendance is open to all service members.

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Best Practice for Assisting Families

Get	When a family is transitioning request records from the school they are leaving.
Provide	Provide the family with the new district information.
Remember	Remember the child's environment has changed so they may need additional supports due to the changes and new environment.
Help	Help the family contact a local parent group.
Connect	Connect the family with the local parent center.

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Exceptional Family Member Program




The Navy's Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) is conducting a three-year pilot projected to enhance existing EFMP special education services. Commander, Navy Installations Command (CNIC), in collaboration with Navy Judge Advocate General (JAG), is expanding special education support and legal assistance to families enrolled in the Exceptional Family Member Program.

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Exceptional Family Member Program

FFSC EFMP Case Liaisons

- Initial EFMP special education contact.
- Review IEPs and Section 504 plans with families.
- Attend IEP meetings in pilot locations upon request.

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Regional Special Education Liaisons

- Special Education Subject Matter Expert.
- Assist EFMP Families with Special Education issues.
- Review IEPs and Section 504s with families.
- Attend IEP meeting in pilot locations upon request.
- Make referrals to appropriate special education professionals within their communities.


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Special Education/EFMP Attorneys

- Advise and assist EFMP families on special education issues that are beyond the scope of Family Support Staff.
- Provide training to EFMP support staff and families on specialneeds topics and special education.
- Provide legal advice and representation when required.

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Exceptional Family Member Program


School Liaison Officers

- Offer assistance in navigating the administrative systems within local public schools
- Serves as a resource to Families and EFMP staff on issues related to local school policies and regulations pertaining to special education
- Provide responses to inquiries regarding school enrollment options
- Identify and refer families that could benefit from enrolling in EFMP

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
