Accomplishments:

- The Wyoming Department of Education, along with Governor Mark Gordon and the Wyoming Military Department, awarded Wyoming's first Purple Star Elementary School – Freedom Elementary at a ceremony at the Wyoming State Capitol. Principal/MIC3 State Commissioner, Chad Delbridge, and 6th grade student Hailey Woods from Freedom Elementary spoke at the ceremony. Also, Wyoming's first Purple Star Junior High – McCormich Junior High, and Wyoming's first Purple Star High School – Central High School were awarded Purple Star Status from the Govenor's office.
- The State Council supported the first Senior Purple Cord Recognition Ceremony at F.E. Warren AFB through attendance.
- Wyoming MIC3 Commissioner and principal of Freedom Elementary was selected to attend a Civic Leader Tour to learn more about the Air Force Global Strike Command mission and witness the world's premier nuclear deterrence capabilities firsthand. Tour stops included Ellsworth Air Force Base, SD and Vandenberg Space Force Base, CA
