- Military Interstate Children's Compact Commission (MIC3)
 - The Compact allows for uniform treatment as military children transfer between school districts in member states.
 - School Liaisons work closely with families and School Districts to ensure there
 is compliance with the Compact.
- Who do School Liaisons Serve?
 - School Liaisons provide support to Department of Defense (DoD) Total Force members.
 - Every service branch has school liaisons assigned to each installation to support service members with your child's educational needs
