February 4: Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio

Ohio Commissioner Pete LuPiba and Interim Executive Director Lindsey Dablow facilitated a Compact 101 Training as part of the Montgomery County Career Champions Meeting. The event was attended by more than 50 school counselors.



February 12: Fort Benning, Georgia

Georgia Commissioner Curtis Jones and MIC3 Interim Executive Director Lindsey Dablow provided training to school leaders from the surrounding districts at the annual Superintendent's Roundtable.



February 17-20: San Diego, Monterey, & Beale Air Force Base, California

In collaboration with California Commissioner Dominick Robinson and School Liaisons, MIC3 Trainer Susan Haberstroh delivered three Compact 101 and Compact 201 Trainings— covering an impressive 850 miles in four days! These trainings were attended by 100 school administrators, counselors, registrars, and support staff.



Did you know?

Has your child successfully completed a ninth-grade course at their sending school, yet been required by the receiving school to take an end-of-course assessment in twelfth grade in order to meet local graduation or course-completion requirements?

Compact Rule, SEC. 4.102 Exit Exams

(a) Exit exams – States shall accept: 1) exit or end-of-course exams required for graduation from the sending State; or 2) national norm-referenced achievement tests; or 3) alternative testing, in lieu of testing requirements for graduation in the receiving State. In the event the above alternatives cannot be accommodated by the receiving State for a student transferring in his or her senior year, then the provisions of SEC. 4.103 shall apply.

March 26th: Ethics in Action: Applying Ethical Standards in Financial Counseling

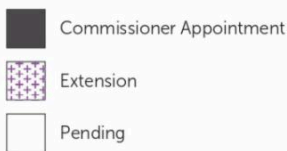
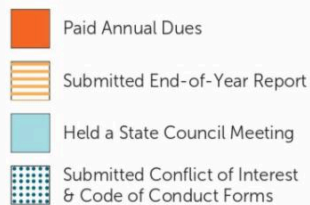
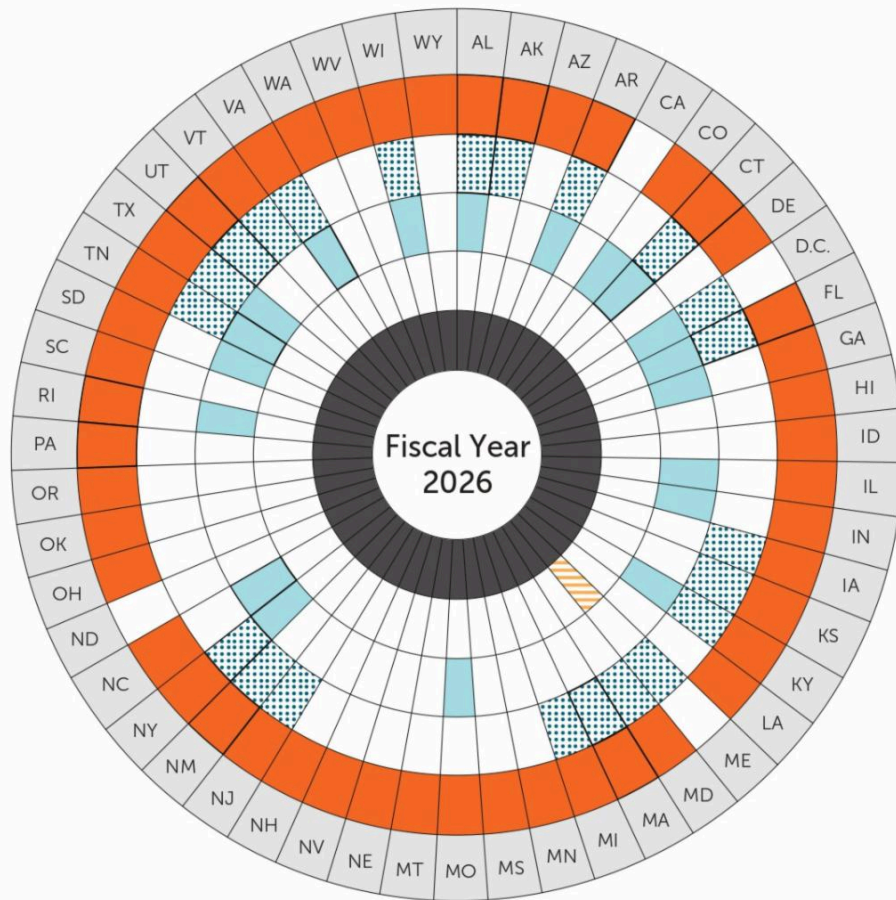
