MIC3 NAMES NEXT PERMANENT EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

LEXINGTON, KY - The Military Interstate Children's Compact Commission is proud to announce the hiring of its next Executive Director, Lindsey Dablow. Ms. Dablow has served as MIC3 Interim Executive Director since August of 2025. Prior to that, she served eight years as Deputy Director and Training and Operations Associate for MIC3.

Ms. Dablow will serve as the organization's fourth Executive Director. Her selection followed a nationwide executive search, dozens of applicants and interviews, both virtual and in-person.

Ms. Dablow was selected for her clear depth of knowledge of the Compact and MIC3, her demonstrated leadership capabilities for the Commission and National Office, and her vision for the future of MIC3 and the Compact for uniformed-connected students and families.

Ms. Dablow shared, "I am deeply grateful for the opportunity to serve as the next Executive Director of MIC3. Over my nine years with the organization, I have been privileged to hear countless stories of resilience from uniformed-connected children and families navigating educational transitions. As the Commission enters the next phase of outreach on the Compact, we remain committed to ensuring these students receive the educational continuity and support they deserve."
